
What's Included?

What's Different?

In a Direct Primary Care (DPC) practice, you receive medical services the way they were meant to be delivered: directly between you and your doctor with no interference from third party payers. As a result, we have significantly decreased administrative costs that allow us to deliver all of the primary care services you need with incredible savings. We then pass those savings on to our patients through affordable monthly membership fees. We are also able to provide lab services, equipment, and supplies, and we dispense our own medications giving our members access to prescriptions at much lower wholesale prices. Even patients with traditional insurance save money on their healthcare in a DPC practice compared to a traditional doctor's office. Oftentimes, the savings is enough to pay for the membership!

FAQ

Do I still need insurance?

We recommend our patients still have health insurance coverage (including Medicare with supplements if eligible). We do not file or accept any insurance or government payments, but you should be able to obtain outside services as you normally would for specialists, imaging, and ER and hospital care if needed. With access to cost-effective, comprehensive primary care, our patients can often afford "catastrophic" insurance plans to cover emergency and unforeseen expenses. Our reasonable memberships also allow people who can't afford insurance to get the primary care they need. Some health sharing ministries may reimburse for your membership.

What if I need a referral?

We will refer you for tests and specialist evaluations if needed which can be processed through your insurance as normal per your policy.

What if I need to be hospitalized?

Our doctors will care for you if you're admitted to Ashe Memorial. The hospital will still bill your insurance for the stay.

Can I use HSA money to pay for your membership?

You should check with your HR department as rules vary.

What if I decide to cancel?

We hope to care for patients who value their relationship with our doctors. If you are unhappy with your care, you may cancel your membership at any time. There will be a fee to rejoin later. Additional details can be found in our patient contract.
